Market Sounding (THIS IS NOT A TENDERING EXERCISE)

Service: The provision of services for the treatment of mixed organic kitchen and garden waste arising from within the North West Region Waste Management Group area.

Background – This tender process will deal with the fraction of mixed organic kitchen and garden wastes. The NWRWMG have prepared a Waste Management Plan for the region, which was adopted in early 2007. A copy of the Waste Management Plan can be obtained at the web address: www.northwestwaste.org.uk

The Implementation of this Plan will require procurement of a series of facilities and/or services. The Plan makes provision for the rolling out of **mixed organic waste**. The envisioned tonnage per annum of mixed organic kitchen and garden waste to be collected is 15,000.

Accordingly, the NWRWMG is considering the issue of a tender for the: ‘the provision of services for the treatment of mixed organic kitchen and garden waste arising from collections within the North West Region’.
